

# **STATUTORY CONSULTATION**

## **THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNCIL (PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING) AND (ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2021 (AMENDMENT 00\*) ORDER 202\***

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to introduce a Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of Part I and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

It is proposed to introduce parking restrictions around St Louis School, Harris Court, and the surrounding roads to facilitate the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic including pedestrians.
