

The Buckinghamshire Council
(Speed Limit) Order 2021
(Amendment No *) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to make the above-mentioned Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Regulation 7 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996. The effect of the Order will be to introduce a new 30mph speed limit restriction on the following length of road:

ROAD NAME	LENGTH OF ROAD AFFECTED
Stablebridge Road	From its junction with London Road southwards to a point approximately 80 metres south of Wellonhead Bridge, for a distance of approximately 401 metres in a southerly direction
