## The Buckinghamshire Council (Speed Limit) Order 2021 (Amendment No \*) Order 202\*

Notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to make the abovementioned Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Regulation 7 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996. The effect of the Order will be to introduce a new 30mph speed limit restriction on the following length of road:
