

STATEMENT OF REASONS

THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNCIL (PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING) AND (ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2021 (AMENDMENT 00*) ORDER 202*

It is proposed to introduce parking restrictions at various locations in Stoke Mandeville in order to address concerns relating to inconsiderate parking.

The table below identifies proposed changes to restrictions for the streets named and the reasons for proposing the restrictions.

Road Name	Type of Parking Restrictions	Reasons
Dorchester Close	No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines – <i>to be effective 24 hours a day, 7 days a week</i>)	For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising. For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians) For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

Dorchester Close / Walnut Close (at junction)	No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines – <i>to be effective 24 hours a day, 7 days a week</i>)	
Walnut Close	No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines – <i>to be effective 24 hours a day, 7 days a week</i>)	
	No Waiting between 10am and 11am from Monday to Friday (Single Yellow Line)	
Carters Ride	Restricted Zone (<i>Effective from Monday to Friday between 10am and 11am</i>)	
	No Waiting between 10am and 11am from Monday to Friday (Single Yellow Line)	
Carters Ride (at junction with Dorchester Close)	No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines – <i>to be effective 24 hours a day, 7 days a week</i>)	
Hampden Road / Orchard Close (at junction)	No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines – <i>to be effective 24 hours a day, 7 days a week</i>)
