

TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES - STOMP ROAD, BURNHAM

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Buckinghamshire Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 90A – 90F of the Highways Act 1980, The Highways (Traffic Calming) Regulations 1999 and after consultation with the Chief of Police, proposes to construct a raised table on Stomp Road, Burnham, at the location specified below:

Location	Type	Dimensions
Outside Nos 109 and 111 Stomp Road (approximately 90 metres west of the junction with Aldbourne Road)	Full width raised table (replacing existing speed cushions)	8.7 m long, of a maximum height of 100mm, with slopes at 1:15 (subject to tolerances in the Regulations)

A copy of the Plan showing the length of road affected together with a copy of the Council's Statement of Reasons for proposing to install the raised table may be inspected by appointment, through the email provided at the bottom of this notice, Monday to Friday between 9am and 5pm at Buckinghamshire Council, Council Access Plus, Walton Street, Aylesbury, HP20 1UA.
