STATUTORY CONSULTATION

The Buckinghamshire Council (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) Order 202* (Amendment No *) Order 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Buckinghamshire Council proposes to introduce a new 75-millimetre high raised table crossing under Sections 90A-90F of the Highways Act 1980, to be located on Thame Road, Haddenham. In addition, the proposal seeks to convert sections of existing footway to pedestrian and shared use paths under Section 65 of the Highways Act 1980, Section 3(1) of the Cycle Tracks Act 1984 and Regulation 3 of the Cycle Tracks Regulations 1984.

The effect of the above proposed Order will be to amend the existing parking restriction to accommodate the proposed crossing and relocated bus stops as part of crossing improvements on Thame Road, Haddenham.
