Dear Resident,

Statutory Consultation for the introduction of parking restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) along Tibbs Road, Haddenham

Buckinghamshire Highways are proposing to introduce some double yellow lines on Tibbs Road, Haddenham. The restrictions are being introduced to create a safer environment for pedestrians and road users as well as encourage compliance with the Highway Code Rule 243, which prohibits parking opposite or within 10 metres of a junction.

Whilst this was consulted back in November 2021, we are reconsulting as a Traffic Regulation Order has to be made within two years of a proposal first being made public.

We will develop the proposals based on what residents and key stakeholders within the area tell us. If the feedback provided shows people support the proposal, we will begin the process of implementing this speed limit, and we will update you again to confirm the proposal.
